Registration Fee: \$65.00

5 days \$175.00

Adventurers (8-11):
3 days (T-W-Th) \$175.00
5 days \$200.00

Counselors-in-Training (13-15):
10% off camp price of the camp that your child will train. Assigned age group will be decided upon enrollment.

Camp is open from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; however activities on any given day may occur anytime during the day. Weekly schedules will be disbursed with specific instructions regarding each day's activities.

All campers need to complete an application and return it to the front office. Applications must be turned in with registration fee of \$65.00 and 1st week's tuition. All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Camps fill up fast, and spaces will be provided on a first come basis. Please bring your completed application, together with your registration fee and 1st week's tuition to the office as soon as possible to ensure your position.
